- Oversee student-led initiative projects, supervise study hall, tutor students in need additional academic support
- Prepare and deliver PE classes
- Serve as a positive role model at all times for all TGS students, specifically with regards to personal wellness and social conduct.
- Know, observe and support TGS policies, and act as a resource and guide for TGS students.
