Position Overview

The StudentLIFE Advisor is a full time position. The employee will be responsible for assisting the Coordinator of StudentLIFE with the daily boarding operations of THINK Global School (TGS). The StudentLIFE Advisor will help to supervise the students, enforce student expectations and consequences, assist with scheduling of travel and activities, and serve as a positive role model. Qualified candidates will also have the opportunity to teach and/or tutor in Spanish.

Responsibilities:

- Live with TGS students and supervise them during the evening and on weekends (in a rotation)
- Assist with daily boarding operations: enforce expectations and consequences, check student rooms, supervise study hall
- Assist with the scheduling of travel, pick ups, free time, and weXplore trips
- Know, observe and support TGS policies
- Serve as a positive role model, resource and guide for TGS students at all times
